Excursion to Dakar and Gorée

Day trips to Dakar, Gorée Island, African Renaissance status We'll pick you up at your hotel at 9 a.m. and take you by air-conditioned vehicle to the port of Dakar. Here, a ferry to Goree Island awaits you.

After a 20-minute boat ride, you'll arrive on the small Senegalese island, designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1978. Off the coast of Dakar, it was one of Africa's most important slave markets for over three centuries.

To find out more about this sad period in African history, visit the Maison des Esclaves. This fascinating museum explains how thousands of people were sold in this terrifying place. Fortunately, it all came to an end in 1848, when slavery was abolished in France.

As you set off, you'll walk through the island's picturesque, narrow streets, with colonial houses adorned with colorful bougainvillea. These flowers bring a lot of joy to Gorée! What's more, the walk will take you to discover the island's beach and give you an insight into how the inhabitants live today.

After the tour, you'll return to a ferry and return to the port of Dakar, from where we'll take you back to your hotel.

Excursion to the Fathala Reserve

The Fathala Reserve is an animal sanctuary located in the south of Senegal, in the Fatick region, between Toubacouta and the border with Gambia. Open to tourism over 2,000 hectares, it is part of the Fathala classified forest (11,800 hectares), which corresponds to the terrestrial part of the Saloum Delta National Park. The nomination of the Saloum delta as a World Heritage site includes the Fathala forest area.

4 Joal-Fadiouth

Visit the amazing seashell island with your guide Babacar from Trip Travel Senegal.

Joal-Fadiouth is a commune located at the southern end of Senegal's Little Coast, just before the Sine Saloum.

Joal-Fadiouth is usually referred to as such, but the name actually refers to two quite distinct villages, even though they now belong to the same commune: Joal is the one on the mainland, while Fadiouth is an island, linked to Joal by a wooden bridge. Fadiouth is the one most visited by tourists, which is easy to understand: it's an original and picturesque place that really deserves a stop!

Joal is an unremarkable village, but it's also interesting because it's one of Senegal's largest fishing ports and the birthplace of Léopold Sédar Senghor, Senegal's first president.


5 Brousse market, Saloum islands and shellfish island
